**Ganakalabhushana Vid. Dr. R K Padmanabha** Sir, is a virtuoso and walking encyclopedia in the field of Carnatic music. His birth is not just an act, but for a meritorious purpose. Born on 26th September 1949 in **Rudrapatna**, Hassan district, he is a distinguished musician in the field of Carnatic music. Growing up in a culturally rich environment, he completed his B.Sc. Honors from Bangalore University and began his musical journey at the age of 25, under the guidance of Vid. Nanjundaswamy, Vid. H R Seetharamashastri and Vid. H V Krishnamurthy.

## Dr. RKP Sir as a Successful Musician

Dr. RKP Sir's concerts are known for their **traditional and disciplined approach**. He is a musical architect who builds an obelisk, which includes all the components of Carnatic music, highly educative and thoughtful for music students. Also, every concert has experimentations which give room for explorations, add new dimensions to his music and to the audience as well. He is recognized for his unique style, characterized by **long notes**, **a full-throated voice**, and elements of the **Nadaswara bani**. His music is always **'common-man centric'**. His music is accessible to a wide audience, as he gives brief explanations before renditions to engage listeners.

### **Dr. RKP Sir's Musical Innovations**

Dr. RKP Sir has contributed 2 unique 'tanas', to the field of Carnatic music, the 'Bhringa Tana' and the 'Rudra Tana'. He has also introduced 37 new ragas to the field of Carnatic music. He has brought out lesser known jathis (of Talas) such as Divya Sankeerna and Mishra Sankeerna out of the theory books to the mainstream.

#### Dr. RKP Sir as a Guru

In 1990, Dr. RKP Sir established 'Sharada Kala Kendra' at JP Nagar, Bangalore. RKP Sir has his own, unique modus operandi of teaching. He follows an interdisciplinary approach and 'multi-route, multi-event, multi-environment







methodology'. He organizes Gaana-Chakra, Gana-Shibira, Gudi-Gana, etc., a series of performances for and by his students for self introspection and skill development. As a dedicated guru, Dr. RKP Sir has a significant influence on his students' lives. He has trained hundreds of students in 'Ghoshti Gayana' (Group singing), whom he proudly declares as his 'Gana Sainya'. His personal philosophy emphasizes the power of music to connect with common people, and he often states, "My Students are my Asset". He handwrites and documents all compositions, shows his commitment to students' learning.

## Dr. RKP Sir as a Composer

Dr. RKP Sir is a prolific composer, with over 700 compositions under the pen name 'Padmanabha Dasa'. Some of his works include Kannada Navagraha Krithis, compositions in 72 Melakartha ragas and 100 Soundaryalahari tuned in 100 ragas. He has also published numerous books, including "Vadiraja Krithi Mala," "Navagraha Krithis of Muttuswami Dikshithar," and "Thyagaraja Sankeertana Mala". His contributions extend to over 100 books and CDs, 4 musical features, and 5 musical novels.

## Dr. RKP Sir as an Architectural Enthusiast

Dr. RKP Sir established 'Vadiraja Kala Bhavana' in the year 1999, a magnificent building which is located in Akshayanagar, Bangalore. The premises includes a dome shaped meditation hall 'Vadiraja Dhyana Mandira', 'Vasudeva Gana Mandira', 'Sharada Kutira' and 'Bhootaraja Shakti Mantapa' which is the recent addition. He is the man behind two architectural marvels, the 'Saptaswara Devata Dhyana Mandira', dedicated to sapta swaras that symbolize the Goddess Saraswati and doyens of Carnatic music and the 'Dwadasha Swara Sthamba Mantapa' dedicated to the 12 notes of Indian music system in Rudrapatna.

   Ragamalika, swarajathis of Shyama Shastri, Ghana Pancharatna of Thyagaraja through Goshti gayana.
- To have the honor of a street named after him at Chikkallasandra, Bangalore.
- To have popularized and immortalized more than 200 compositions of Sri Vadiraja Swamy and about 200 compositions of Sri Mysore Vasudevacharya through books and CDs.
- To have written charismatic, insightful, informative and heartwarming novels namely 'Ananthanaada', 'Nada Bindu', 'Vipra Vikrama', 'Suvarnagana' and 'Bevu Bella'. These novels are a rational amalgamation of philosophy and scientific approach towards music. He has also written several kavanas in kannada, titled "Padmakavite".
- He has also authored a research oriented book named
   'Purandaradasaru Sangeeta Pitamahare? Re.', 'Shri Vadiraja
   Pavadagalu, a book on 'Voice Culture' and many articles.
- To have received two Honorary Doctorates from prestigious universities: Srividya International University for Vedic Science, Florida and Sri Satya Sai University for Human Excellence, Muddenahalli.
- To script, compose, direct and enact musical plays such as 'Vadiraja Vaibhava', 'Naada', 'Purandara mahima' and 'Nadayogi Tyagayya'.
- To have sung alapana of Raga Kalyani in all 12 shruthis.
- To have been recognized and honored with a POSTAL COVER in his name by the Postal Department.
- To have received the Sangeet Natak Akademi Award 2020 from the President of India.
- To have received 113 titles and 55 awards to his credit.







## RKP Sir's accomplishments and contributions to Rudrapatna and Arakalagud

- Built a two storied building called 'Sharada Mandira', a building with lodging and a dining hall with kitchen at Rudrapatna.
- Has formed a planned layout called 'NADALOKA' at Rudrapatna
- Has renovated Rama Mandira, Anjaneya temple, Rameshwara temple, Ammana Gudi at Rudrapatna.
- Has adopted the Government Primary School at Rudrapatna by donating liberally for the construction of washrooms for girls and boys, Rangamantapa, for school events, etc.
- Has also contributed to **Vidyashankara High School** in **Rudrapatna** for constructing a **Rangamantapa**, **several classrooms**, and more.
- Has offered scholarships to few students for helping them complete their higher education.
- Under his able leadership, a free eye camp was conducted for the villagers in Rudrapatna.
